DEED OF GIFT

WHEREAS, the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club, since its inception, has from time to time been the recipient of the expenditure of time, effort and devotion to the affairs of the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club, by various individuals and

WHEREAS, to this time, there has been no way of recognizing such individuals and making their contributions known to the present and future membership of the Club; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed fitting and proper that the services of these outstanding individuals be recognized through an appropriate selection process and the award to them of a perpetual trophy in recognition of their services to the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the affection reserved to the recipients of the following award, and in consideration of the meritorious and outstanding services rendered by those individuals so honored, this Deed of Gift is made to the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club, pursuant to the following suggested terms and conditions:

The Commodore's Cup Award is a perpetual trophy symbolically awarded from time to time as a worthy candidate becomes clearly apparent in terms of long standing, devoted and dedicated service to the Club.

This award may be made on a yearly basis. However, it is expressly conditioned that there is nothing contained herein that required the presentation of this award on a yearly basis. It is the intention of the donors that this award should be made only when there is a qualified recipient. Route annual award giving may serve only to denigrate the value and meaning of the award. Time is a criterion since the award should be awarded for service where sufficient time has passed for proper perspective to develop.

The selection for the recipient (male or female) of this award shall be made by the present (retiring) commodore and the two most recently retired commodores, and past recipients of the award who are currently active members. Currently seated flag officers in any award year are not eligible for the award.

In addition to the bestowing upon the recipient of the perpetual trophy, presented with this Deed of Gift, it is respectfully suggested that there be presented to the recipient upon each presentation a "keeper" award to be provided by the Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club and to be inscribed thereon, the name of the recipient, and the year awarded.
